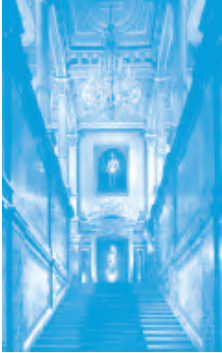
### ADMISSION
